1. Adjustable Torque Wrench 3/8 drive 0-300 inch pounds range
2. In-line second stage adjustment tool – ScubaTools recommended or 5mm hex wrench
3. Soft Jawed Vise
4. 1st Stage Handle for HP and LP ports
5. 3/4 inch 3/8th drive socket for Yoke assembly *use with item 7
6. 13/16 inch 3/8th drive socket
7. ScubaTools 3/8th drive 3 inch extension –
SKU: 20- 156-500
8. 6mm 3/8-inch drive Hex Head male socket
9. 5mm hex head wrench
10. 4mm 3/8 drive hex socket
11. 2 Adjustable Wrenches
12. Brass Picks for removing O-rings
