Day 1 : Ambon

Our staff will pick you up at the airport for immediate boarding. Depending on the arrival time, we might do the check dive around Laha or Tulehu Bay and maybe even a night dive. Laha or Tuleu Bay: area known for its fabulous muck dives, probably among the best in the world for macro diving.

Day 2: Nusa Laut & Molana

South of Seram, fantastic diving experiences on the reefs of Molana and Nusa Laut. These rather picturesque islands of Maluku are popular dive destinations due to their diversity of reef fish species, ghost pipefish, frogfish and the variety of well-preserved hard corals. We have seen sperm whales in the area so keep your eyes open.

Day 3-5: Banda Islands, outer reefs

The Banda Islands are part of the Spice Islands and home to nutmeg plantations, an active volcano and historic Dutch fort on the island of Banda Neira. The diving off the Banda Islands will dazzle divers with chances to see mandarin fish, schooling hammerheads, whales – pygmy and pilots, and eagle rays cruising off the walls.

Day 6-7 Triton Bay

Located at Namatote in Triton Bay, fishing platforms have evolved into one of the top dive spots in the world for whale sharks. Divers are drawn to Triton Bay for whale sharks and then wowed by macro-life & seamounts covered in soft coral and patrolled by giant trevally, dogtooth tuna, and wobbegong sharks hidden under massive plate coral.

Day 8-11 Misool & Raja Ampat

Top dive sites include Boo Window, Magic Mountain, Farondi Island, Cape Kri & Blue Magic. Raja Ampat is known as being one of the world's most biodiverse destinations. Highlights include pygmy seahorses, napoleon wrasse, wobbegong and epaulette sharks, vibrant coral and manta rays.

Day 12

A nice breakfast onboard followed and then our crew can arrange for transfer to Sorong Airport (SOQ) or local hotel. Unfortunately we have to say goodbye but we hope to see you again soon.
